SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are set to guide the learners have a better life and better learning environment at school.

1. **Punctuality:** All students must keep time for all school activities. The school timetable and schedule of activities must be observed at all times.
2. Every student must **obtain permission** from the relevant authorities in order to leave school and to interact with any visitor/other outsider
3. Unnecessary noise and any form of disorderliness and hooliganism is strictly forbidden
4. **Respect to Authority:** All students must respect all people in whom authority is vested.
5. All religious activities or functions in school must be observed, attended and respected by all students at all times
6. **Behavior and general conduct:** every student must behave decently, and in a manner that does not cause disrepute to the school. Drug abuse, sexual immorality, alcoholism, use of obscene/vulgar language are punishable with suspension
7. **School programs.** All students must attend all school programs without fail. Attendance to evening and morning preps is mandatory to all students in the boarding section.
8. **Respect to school uniform.** Students must dress decently in clean school uniform while at school, on the way to and from school. Skirts must be long enough and trousers must be descent. Non-school wear, high heeled shoes, makeup, polished and painted nails are all prohibited. Hair should be plainly

trimmed; no hair styles /cuts are allowed in school. All uniforms must be bought at school and maintained well.

9. **Illegal items.** Students are prohibited from possessing radios, mobile phones, electric appliances and any other items that the school deems not useful/harmful

10. **Health.** Students must undergo medical checkup whenever required by the administration. All ailments must be reported to the school medical team. Self-medication is prohibited
11. **Respect to property.** Students must respect all school property as well as fellow students' property. Cheating, theft, stealing, possession of stolen property, Vandalism, riots, unjust behavior, attempts to strike are all punishable.
12. Students must take the meals provided by the school.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Breach of the above rules will attract the following:

- a) **A suitable** punishment and warning for the first offender
- b) **Suspension** of the offender for a period of **two consecutive weeks**, and reporting back with a parent to make a commitment
- c) **Indefinite suspension** of the culprit/ offender if no change is realized
