SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Non-school wear, high heeled shoes, makeup, polished and painted nails are all prohibited. Hair should be plainly trimmed; no hair styles /cuts are allowed in school. - 10. Health. Students must undergo medical checkup whenever required by the administration. All ailments must be reported to the school medical team. Selfmedication is prohibited
- 11. **Respect to property**. Students must respect all school property as well as fellow students' property. Cheating, theft, stealing, possession of stolen property, Vandalism, riots, unjust behavior, attempts to strike are all punishable.
- **12.** Students must take the meals provided by the school.
