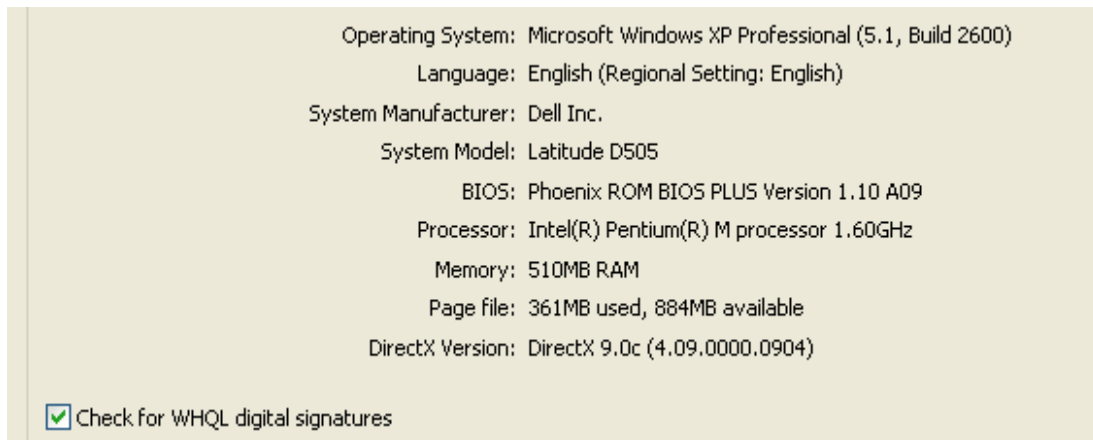

1. The following Information relates to Promise Enterprises for the months of June- September 2018.

- i) On June 1.2018 the enterprises had a cash balance of shs 40,000,000.
- ii) The business expected cash sales of shs 8,000,000 per month.
- iii) Credit sales were perfected at shs 2,500,000 per month for which 60% payment were to be made in the following month and the balance after one month from the month sales for all sales.
- iv) Rent income was to increase by 10% monthly.
- v) Rent to be received on June 1.2018 was shs 600,000.
- vi) Monthly cash purchases were projected at shs 7,000,000,
- vii) Machinery worth shs 6,000,000 was to be brought bought in June and cash payment of shs 3.800,000 made and the balance to be paid in installment of 30%, 30% and 40% in the next months.
- viii) The business was not to get a loan of shs 5,000,000 in the month of July.
- ix) 5% P.a interest on loan was to be paid a month after one month grace period.
- x) Credit purchases of shs 3,000,000 were made in June; the business has, a policy of paying for credit purchases in credit purchases in three equal monthly instalments after one month.
- xi) The business has a policy of paying 2% sales commission monthly on cash sales of every month. The business was to sell some old furniture worth shs 800,000 in June. Shs 500,000 was received and the balance was to be received in the next month.
- xii) The business is to clear any cash shortfall using a Ricard debenture at the beginning of the next month.
